



60 YEAR ANNIVERSARY FOUNDER'S COSMETOLOGY SCHOLARSHIP

PURPOSE:

In honor of Richard Gross, the founder of Salon Success Academy, 60 Cosmetology students will receive scholarships in the amount of \$1,000 each

- 48 Cosmetology tuition awards
- 12 MUD Beauty Essentials class awards (See MUD Scholarship Flyer for Information)

QUALIFYING CRITERIA:

In order for a student to receive a Cosmetology Founder's Scholarship the following requirements must be met:

- Be enrolled in the Cosmetology program at Salon Success Academy for 1600 clock hours (no prior hours) with a start date on or after January 20, 2020
- Attend a full time (35hpw) schedule throughout the duration of the program
- Maintain 95% or better attendance and 75% or better GPA at each SAP evaluation point
 - 450 scheduled hours
 - 900 scheduled hours
 - 1250 scheduled hours
 - 1600 scheduled hours
- Graduate within the originally contracted time frame

HOW TO APPLY FOR THE SCHOLARSHIP:

- Complete the scholarship application
- Make a short (under 3 minutes) video or write an essay 1000 words or less to discuss the following two topics:
 - 1) Tell us why you want a career in the beauty industry and
 - 2) Describe any challenges or obstacles you've dealt with and overcome in your life and how these experiences will enable you to have a successful career in the beauty industry.
- Upload the video to Instagram

 - Include your full name and campus in your email
- Submit the application and essay (if applicable) to your Admissions Representative or Campus Director. Essays must be typed. Handwritten essays will not be accepted.

WHEN AWARD WILL BE ANNOUNCED

- Students will be notified that they have met the preliminary criteria and have been selected as a scholarship candidate after completing at least one (1) month of school.

WHEN THE FUNDS WILL BE APPLIED TO THE ACCOUNT:

- As long as the student meets all benchmarks for attendance and academics, \$1000 will be applied to their account during payment period four (4).
- Scholarship candidates who lose eligibility will not be able to regain the award.
